Dear Parish Family,

It is hard to believe that we are already in the middle of July. Independence Day is in the review mirror and hopefully some warm summer days and cool summer evenings are still in front of us. As our summer journey continues, I would like to reflect on our scripture readings this weekend.

Our readings this weekend are extremely powerful. They are a source of comfort but at the same time a challenge for us to do more to build up the kingdom of God. The first reading from Amos teaches us that God chooses us and not the other way around. Just as importantly, God does not choose us based on the skills we believe we possess but upon the gifts He will give us. God will give us the grace we need to do what He asks of us.

Paul, in the second reading, confirms this when He states that God "has blessed us in Christ, with every spiritual blessing in the heavens". We were chosen by God to accomplish His Will and are given all that we need to accomplish the tasks we are given by God. Just think about that for a moment. God has given you every spiritual blessing: not just a few spiritual blessings, every spiritual blessing. In the Gospel, Jesus sends out His disciples to continue the work He has begun. He gives his disciples the power to bring healing, support, and compassion to those who are suffering in the world. As the Father has sent the Son, so the Son sent His disciples, and so now we are being sent. We have been given all that we need to continue the work of Christ in the world, to build up the Kingdom of God. The question for each of is: Will we accept the challenge to follow Jesus Christ and help build up the kingdom of God?

May God bless you, Mary our Mother watch over you, and St. Gregory the Great intercede for you.

On December 16, 2017, our lives were forever changed. My heart was shattered. My family was devastated. That was the day my oldest son, Devin, took his own life, just three months after his 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. To say that I was blindsided would be an understatement. Devin was an incredibly gifted athlete. He was dedicated to keeping himself fit and planned on enlisting in the Marine Corps this June.

Devin's true gift, however, was his presence. He could walk into a room and not only light it up but control it with his mere being. Devin had a way about him that drew people in. He had more friends than one could imagine, and he loved every one of them. When I look at the faces of those kids and see

the impact which Devin's death had on so many, I know that I must do something to try to spare another family from experiencing the same pain that we are living through.

Unfortunately, stories like my family's are far too common. Stories like Devin's happen more than anyone wants to talk about. Suicide is the second leading cause of death for kids aged 10–24. More teenagers and young adults die from suicide than from cancer, heart disease, AIDS, birth defects, stroke, pneumonia, influenza, and chronic lung disease, COMBINED.

This is the reason we are hosting **Drive for Devin**. On Friday, July 27, 2018 a 9-hole golf tournament in Devin's memory will be played at Deerwood Golf Course in North Tonawanda, followed by a dinner at Classics V on Niagara Falls Blvd. The money raised from this tournament will go to support children, teens and adults in their time of crisis. Crisis Services provides treatment and assistance to people in emotional crisis through a variety of therapeutic services. I want people to know that help is always there if they find themselves in crisis." **You Are Never Alone.**"




