I am very grateful that we finally have a new Baptismal Font which was custom built for our church. I am also very grateful for the individual who came forward to donate this font for the parish. It is important to note that the Baptismal Font, originally to be part of the Upon this Rock campaign proceeds, was paid for by a private donor who came forward to make this gift during the time of the Upon this Rock campaign. I am most thankful that our parish once again has a proper font to celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism and to welcome all of our newly initiated. May God bless you for your goodness to us!

Finally, a word about Catholic Charities: This year's goal for St. Gregory's is \$692,989. We are at \$628,916 of that goal. We have \$64,073 to go. First, I thank everyone who has already given their gift this year. May God truly bless you as you look after the poorest among us who are served by Catholic Charities. Next, I humbly ask everyone who has not given to please consider doing so. There are many of our "regular" donors who we have not yet heard from. If you are like me, the mail can stack up and it becomes nothing more than oversight. I urge you to please consider making your donation again this year.

For those of us who have been in Buffalo for many years, we know that Catholic Charities was dubbed "The drive that never fails." For decades that was true. In recent years the campaign has struggled to meet its goal. The goal was usually achieved by Palm Sunday, and now it is a photo finish to make the goal by June 30th. The recent issue involving the inappropriate behavior of priests over the last half century has definitely taken its toll on Catholic Charities this year. I assure you, as Bishop Malone has already assured us: no money from Catholic Charities is going to the Independent Compensation Fund for Victims of Abuse. *Please do not allow this crisis of our diocese to negatively affect the neediest among us.*

Finally, about two-thirds of our parish does not contribute to Catholic Charities. I humbly ask you to consider becoming part of the Catholic Charities family. If we all work together our goal will be met. The real goal is not just the \$692,989. The real goal is giving as best as we can to help our brothers and sisters in need. The real goal is simply living our call to charity as a disciple of Christ. Thank you for all you have done and will do for Catholic Charities this year. May God bless you, our Mother Mary watch over you and St. Gregory the Great intercede for you, always.



California's Assisted Suicide Law Suspended: On May 15, Judge Daniel Ottolia of the Riverside County Superior Court ruled that California lawmakers had unconstitutionally legalized physician-assisted suicide in 2015. The legislature violated the state constitution when it passed the law during a special session supposedly convened to discussing health care funding only.

The initial legislative effort to pass an assisted suicide bill failed in committee during the 2015 regular season.

"The act itself was rushed through the special session of the legislature, and it does not have any of the safeguards one would expect to see in a law like this," said Stephen G. Larson, head counsel for a group of doctors challenging the law. They claim the bill lacked an adequate definition of terminal illness and a provision exempting from legal liability the doctors who prescribe the drugs.

In January 2018, the California Catholic Conference reiterated its opposition to assisted suicide and criticized the lack of data collected and the lack of transparency of the law's implementation.

"There is far too much still not known about how this law is put into practice — especially as it pertains to disabled, elderly and other populations," the conference said Jan. 24. "California is failing to properly investigate ...whether patients were coerced into the procedure, or ...whether they had the option of good, effective palliative care."

California Attorney General Xavier Becerra voiced strong disagreement with the ruling and said he plans to appeal it. (Full text at catholicnewsagency.com)




Catechist's Corner
