#### From the desk of Daniel Victoor

This weekend, on Sunday morning, our Knights of Columbus Council is hosting the Ministry Fair and a Pancake Breakfast in the Ministry Center. Deacon Peter Donnelly recently mentioned in this Bulletin how becoming involved in the parish ministries gave him the opportunity to grow spiritually and to meet new friends in Christ.

Have you considered another step in your spiritual journey? Have you considered joining one of the parish ministries? We have Prayer Oriented Ministries such as Ladies of the Lord and Men of God. We also have Service Oriented Ministries such as Ladies of Charity, St. Vincent de Paul Society, Religious Education Teachers, and the Liturgical Ministries including Music Ministry. Within Music Ministry, we have vocal ensembles and instrumental ensembles, short term ensembles and regular ongoing ensembles, children ensembles and youth ensembles and adult ensembles, contemporary music ensembles and more traditional music ensembles. Our worship aid, *Breaking Bread*, prints the Entrance Antiphons and the Communion Antiphons for every Sunday Mass plus Holy Days of Obligation and other Masses such as Ash Wednesday and Thanksgiving Day. Also, there are Entrance Antiphons and Communion Antiphons printed in the Daily Mass Propers section of *Breaking Bread* for the Masses that occur every day. Have you considered why the publisher would choose to publish these antiphons? By highlighting these texts in our worship aid, the publisher (and the Church) are emphasizing the importance of singing/reading these texts during Mass.

We, however, are accustomed to singing hymns during the Entrance and Communion Processions - so, why publish these antiphons? According to Jason McFarland in his book 'Announcing the Feast: The Entrance Song in the Mass of the Roman Rite', there are five 'Models of the Entrance Song': (1) the Proper Antiphon and Verses of the Graduale Romanum, (2) the Proper or Seasonal Antiphon and Verses of the *Graduale Simplex*, (3) alternate musical settings of the Proper Antiphon and Verses, (4) musical settings of texts other than the Proper Antiphons and Verses (which is what we are accustomed to singing, i.e. hymns), and (5) the spoken Proper Antiphon of the Roman Missal (which is published in *Break*ing Bread as the Entrance and Communion Antiphons). Fr. Leon does recall when these antiphons were normally read during daily Mass.

What is common in the first three 'Models of the Entrance Song' is the inclusion of a Doxology text (Trinitarian text) which was a result of the Council of Nicaea in 325. The inclusion of Doxology Verses on the inside cover of Breaking Bread allows us to use a Trinitarian text with hymns that do not already have this text included. The music used for the two Chant Masses we recently had this past year at St. Greg's would fall under the second model - a more simple chant form, which is in contrast to the more complex chant form found in the first model. There are cathedrals and parishes throughout the world that normally use the first model. There are a number of cathedral musicians that are intrigued with the third model and are now composing/commissioning new compositions with this model in mind.


