ST. GREGORY THE GREAT MASS INTENTIONS 2025

As we continue our Road to Renewal journey, we ask for you to be understanding of our revised policies. Please note the policies listed below are in line with the Code of Canon Law and the Diocese of Buffalo. We handle requests in a way that is fair, honorable and in keeping with the laws of the Church.

- Canon Law requires the scheduling of one *Pro Populo* (for the people) intention on every Holy Day of Obligation (including Sundays). This intention includes all those who live in the boundaries of St. Gregory the Great, regardless of their faith tradition. (*No other intention may be scheduled in conjunction with this*.)
- Canon Law and the Diocese of Buffalo prohibits the scheduling of multiple intentions for one Mass.
- <u>At this time</u>, a maximum of 3 intentions per year for any one individual and from any one person/family may be obtained.
- No holiday or Holy Day Mass times are currently available.
- Each intention is limited to either two names or one group name (e.g. John & Jane Doe or the Doe Family).

The standard stipend for Masses is \$15 (check made payable to St. Gregory). If you are requesting two intentions, please send two forms and one payment. *PLEASE PRINT TO ENSURE ACCURACY*. We will do our best to honor the date requested, but *if the date requested is not available, we will move the Mass to the next closest available date*.
